Our open spaces enable residents to wander around safely within secure walkways. They can use the main high street to visit recognizable places such as the supermarket, or the café to meet with other residents in familiar surroundings with like-minded people.


Environment & Facilities

Ixworth Court is divided into 2 houses with 8 residents living in each house.

Each house is built to the recommended high standards and is equipped with a separate kitchen for cooking, a dining room for eating, and a lounge area for relaxing. All residents have their own bedroom with access to a healthcare bed and an en-suite shower room.

This style of communal living aims to provide a sense of 'home from home' providing normal household routines whilst living in familiar surroundings and having daily contact with small groups of people. This approach positively sets us apart from larger care homes and provides an environment that is proven to reduce symptoms sometimes associated with dementia, including confusion; fear; agitation; and regression.

The Specialist Dementia Care Home has been purpose-built to represent typical life, it has a street that links the houses; a village hall where there is a shop; visiting markets; activities; a café with outside seating areas; a restaurant; a marquee for outside functions, and a village square with gardens.



The living environment is supported by professional carer's who treat individual wellbeing and care as their priority, all within safe and protected surroundings.

At Ixworth Court you can expect a room with en-suite facilities, and a team dedicated to helping new residents settle. We encourage familiar items and personal belongings within bedrooms, to aid in this settling process.



Safety and peace of mind

- Purpose-built care home on one level that includes specialist equipment; wheelchair access; wide doors; ramps; and coded doors.
- Up-to-date nurse-call monitoring system
- · Fire alarms in all rooms with emergency lighting
- Secure entrance and enclosed gardens

- CMS which stores care records. There is a facility for the family to log on daily and view the given care, activities engaged in, and additional notes.
- Flexible visiting times. Doors close at 10.45pm for the night team to care.
- · Choice of meal times. Choice of daily activities.
